

## COVID-19 Protocols

In an effort to keep our members and guest safe during this time we ask that you comply with the following guidelines:

- If you are ill (fever, cough, vomiting, etc.) or have been around anyone with COVID-19 please stay home. We ask that you be symptom free for 14 days before joining us.
- If you are an at-risk individual and you do not feel comfortable joining us live, a recording of the service will be available online by Monday.
- There will be no Sunday School or any additional activities other than morning worship at 10 a.m.
- Face masks are recommended but not required.
- Hand sanitizer will be available at the door as you enter and leave the building.
- Upon entering the building, we ask that you find your seat immediately and remain in place until dismissed.
- Family units and individuals will sit with at least 6 feet or two seats between them. Chairs will be arranged to accommodate a safe distance.
- Refrain from making physical contact with others at all times.
- Practice good hygiene when visiting the bathroom by washing your hands with soap before exiting.
- Use your elbow to cover coughs and sneezes.
- Nursery care will not be available.
- We will not pass an offering plate. You will have an opportunity to place your tithe in a plate located at the door upon leaving the service.
- There will be no coming forward for counseling or spiritual decisions. You may call the church office or one of the staff to schedule a one on one meeting.
- When the service is concluded, a staff member will dismiss family groups and individuals separately.
- We ask that you leave the church building upon dismissal. Do not linger in the foyer.

Live Oak Staff will continue to stay informed and take actions based on common sense and wise judgment that will protect the health of our church family. We will be mindful of federal and state recommendations and safety standards.
